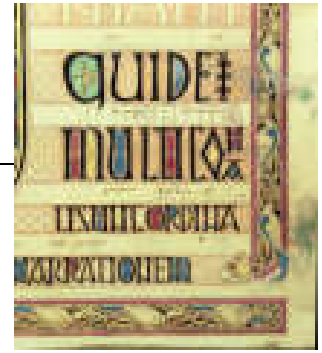

4. What differences are there between the account of Jesus' sending of the 70 disciples (Luke 10) vs. sending of the 12 disciples (Matthew 10)?
5. Why is it that "lawyers" were often those who questioned Jesus? Who were these "lawyers"? Did this help or hurt Jesus' ministry?



6. What is the significance of the account of Mary and Martha? Where else do we find Mary and Martha mentioned?

7. Is the “Parable of the Rich Fool” a “parable”? Why or why not?

8. What do you believe were some of the reasons Jesus taught about wealth and poverty?

9. According to Luke 13, in what ways does Jesus bring “fire” and “division”?
